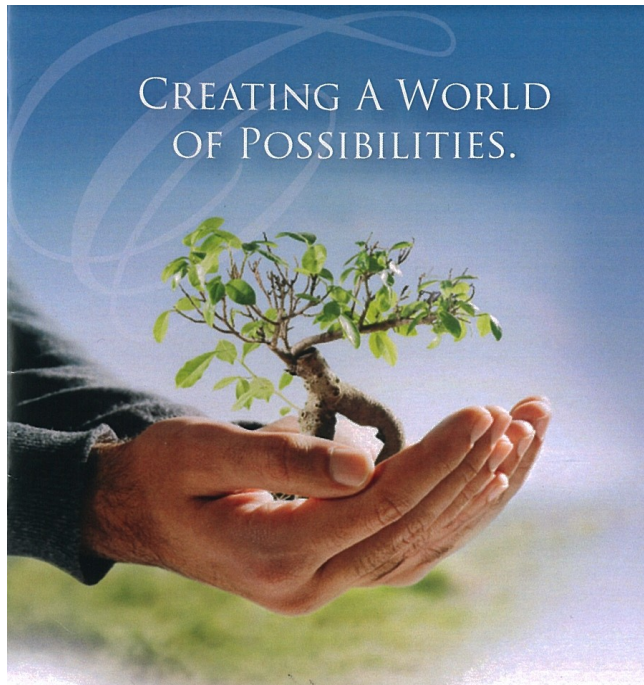
### **Obama to offer amended health care plan**

WASHINGTON — President Barack Obama is unveiling his revised version of a health care bill at the White House. It's expected to include several Republican proposals.

The White House says the president will repeat why reform is so crucial and what it would mean for American families and businesses. And he'll restate his preference for a comprehensive bill.

Later, Obama will sit down separately with the national commander of Disabled American Veterans and the commander of the American Legion.

In the evening, Obama will host a reception for members of Congress in the Blue Room to thank them for reinstating so-called pay-as-you-go rules aimed at balancing the budget. Vice President Joe Biden will also be there.

### Man Walking Across America For Disabled Vets Comes To West Texas 2/27/10

Odessa, TX - A man walking from Florida to California is making big waves in West Texas today.

Richard Hunsucker has never served time over-seas, and he isn't disabled, but he is a Marine-Corps veteran, and that's all the motivation he needs to walk across America for the Disabled American Veterans.

"When I first started a lot of people said one man can't make a difference, but as I walked along with God, I am making a difference." Hunsucker reflected today on the side of Business-20.

Hunsucker is on a journey across America.

"Thought it would be honorable that I carry this flag, Disabled American Veterans flag, which really most of the public doesn't know what it is. I just want to make America aware that when our vets come back from combat or war they've got problems physical and mental." Hunsucker explained while waving his very large D.A.V. flag.

A trip that began Veteran's Day in Florida will end Memorial Day in California.

"God put it in my mind to do this and he assured me that if I have faith, he'd provide for me the means and the way and he's not let me down. He's opened a lot of doors on the way."

Like meeting disabled veteran John Pilgrim from Big Spring. He and his wife fed and housed Hunsucker during last week's snowstorm.

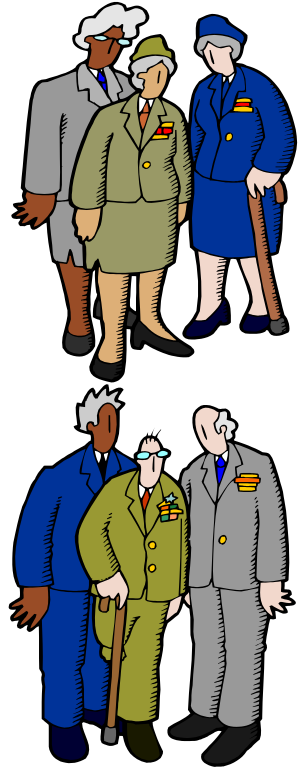
"I was a marine myself, and I think what he's doing is great because he's doing something a lot of us can't do." Pilgrim said of Hunsucker's journey.

Just looking at his pace car, which local veterans in each city take turns driving, you can see the hundreds of people he's already met, but he says he's also walking for our future veterans.

"If they see we aren't providing for our troops that served our country, they won't sign on the dotted line to protect our freedom."

"When I was a young boy I used to feel sorry for the veterans with their arm and leg shot off, as I got older I realized they don't want us to feel sorry for them, so I am proud of them."

Hunsucker's journey will end in San Diego on Memorial Day. The pace car he uses to track his mileage will be auctioned off in San Diego. He says so far he is on pace to make that homecoming.
